- **New 12U, 14U, and 16U Players** (who did not play at WSC during the 2024-25 season) must be approved to attend team evaluations. Please text message WSC Hockey Director, Wally Muehlbronner 267-664-9705 the following information: players name and birth year, position, previous club, and level played during the 2024-25 season (AA, A, B).
 - Coach Muehlbronner will schedule a phone conversation to learn more about your player, answer program questions, and discuss player openings.
 - Players that have had on-ice or off-ice discipline issues will not be approved to attend evaluations. Players with parents that have had disruptive behavior issues at other clubs will not be approved to attend evaluations.

- **2025-26 Youth Hockey Program Fees:** All WSC members pay a Base Membership Fee, that is based on the number of family members participating in a club program. Youth Hockey families also pay a Participant Fee per player/s. The Base Membership Fee, added to the Participant Fee, is your total Membership Cost for the 2025-26 Season.
